SCHOLARSHIPS AND FINANCING

Paideia fellows are eligible for scholarships during their studies at Paideia. The scholarship includes tuition-free studies, a study trip to Israel and a monthly stipend of approximately 800€ per month to cover rent and living costs. The number of scholarships is limited. A student's ability to be financially self-sufficient or to secure external financing will be considered as merit in the admissions process.

MASTER PROGRAMS

As part of its cooperation with other universities, Paideia allows the participants of the Program to study for the joint Master Programs (120 ECTS). Participants in the Program study the Paideia's Program in Stockholm during the first year and advanced modules of Jewish studies at partnership institutions during

the second year. The application for Master Programs is processed after being accepted to Paideia.

1. Master's Program in Jewish Studies entitled M.A. Jewish Civilizations at the Center for Jewish Studies Heidelberg

2. Master's Program in Religious Studies and Theology with specialization in History of Religions at Lund University.
